Music Notes

To change a file name, double click the name, slowly, this allows you to type over the existing name.

If sending a large number of files please use several emails as there can be a limit on an email attachment size.

Your music must be in mp3 format ('.mp3'after the file name).

Doping: Please be aware that any horse competing at a BEV competition in any class could be subject to BEF Equine Anti-Doping ("BEFAR") spot testing at any affiliated event as per BEV rulebook.

Passports: All horses must travel and arrive with their passport. It should be correctly validated, and meet all passport requirements including microchipping, vaccination, Equine Anti-doping and Controlled Medication control. Any equine athlete failing to meet passport requirements may not be allowed to compete.

There will be no pre-competition vetting taking place.

Para-vaulting: Competitors eligible for para-vaulting classes are vaulters with a physical, sensory or intellectual disability. Hats are not required if a non RDA vaulter. Para team can have 2 non para members. Para Pas de deux must both be para competitors.

Eligibility to Compete – See Rulebook plus summary below:

To qualify for a title at the British Championship, a vaulter must hold a British passport, reside in Great Britain and have competed at two National Competitions in the current season.

Vaulters who have not competed in 2 BEV National competition (CVI Onley will be included) during 2022 are eligible to enter but are but not eligible to be British Champion.

BEV encourages all to attend and enter classes. If the event is oversubscribed, entry numbers in some categories may be limited using the BEV rankings system as seen in the rulebook. The rankings are currently being finalised and will be reported shortly. Competitors are encouraged to complete their entries as soon as possible.

Vaccination Requirements. See BEV Rulebook Appendix G. Summary: A horse must have been vaccinated against equine flu within the last 12 months prior to attending our competition. This vaccination must have been administered at least 7 days before arrival at the venue. In addition the horse must have received a qualifying primary course of vaccination comprising 3 doses (the first 2 vaccinations 21-92 days apart and a third booster between 150 - 180 days) and at least annual vaccinations prior to 2022.

ANY HORSES NOT MEETING THESE REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE ABLE TO COMPETE
